

Monthly Bible Memory Guidelines

The entire monthly Bible Memory selection and scripture references must be correctly recited to an adult in one sitting according to the following guidelines:

1. The student will be allowed *three* prompts (a word given that has not been previously said by the student).
2. The adult may repeat anything that the student has already said correctly.
3. The adult may tell the student what verse the student is currently on.
4. The adult may tell the student if he or she said the verse correctly or incorrectly.
5. The student must say the month's scripture reference at the end or the beginning of the recitation.

**Bible Memory must be recited by the last day of the month.
The verification form is due to the student's Bible teacher
by 3:00 p.m. on the 2nd school day of the following month.**

Ideas for study helps:

- ❖ Learn one or two verses a day.
- ❖ Learn the passage along with your child.
- ❖ Make 3x5 cards with verses written on them.
- ❖ Start learning verses early, and be consistent.
- ❖ Have your child say the passage with as many prompts as needed when practicing.
- ❖ Talk about the meanings of the verses and their life applications.
- ❖ Put the verses to a tune and sing the scriptures.
- ❖ Have the student write out the verse.
- ❖ Learn actions that go with key words to help remember the verses.
