_____ Rom. 5:6	For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.
_____ Rom. 5:7	For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die.
_____ Rom. 5:8	But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
_____ Rom. 5:9	Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.
_____ Rom. 5:10	For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.
_____ Rom. 5:11	And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

Gifts of Redemption

- _____ Rom. 6: 4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
- _____ Rom. 6:5 For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection,
- _____ Rom. 6:6 Knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin.
- _____ Rom. 6:7 For he who has died has been freed from sin.
- _____ Rom. 6:8 Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him.
- _____ Rom. 6:9 Knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him.
- _____ Rom 6:10 For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God.
- _____ Rom. 6:11 Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- _____ Rom. 6:12 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts.
- _____ Rom. 6:13 And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.
- _____ Rom. 6:14 For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.
