***Internet Policy* (Grades K-6)**

Dear Parent or Guardian,

The Internet is a powerful educational tool, providing world-wide access to museums, libraries, news, events and other useful resources.

At the same time, there have been concerns about children accessing offensive material, as well as crime, abuse or harassment occurring over the Internet. At Pullman Christian School we are taking precautions to ensure a safe environment for your student.

Precautions we have taken include:

- K-6th grade students are always directly supervised while using the Internet.
- The school has significant filters in place to prevent access to objectionable material.
- K-6th grade students will not be surfing the Internet to conduct online research. The teacher will have pre-selected educational sites accessed for the children. This will help minimize the possibility of pop-ups and other unwanted images.
- You will find an Internet Contract attached. All students and parents are required to sign this agreement before students are allowed to use the Internet. As the parent, you may choose for your child not to participate in Internet research by writing "Choosing not to participate" on the contract.
- Students breaking the rules laid out in this Contract will not be permitted to use our school's computers for a given amount of time, depending on the offense.

- I will tell my teacher right away if I come across information that makes me feel uncomfortable.
- I will never send a person my picture or anything else without first checking with my teacher.
- I will always treat people online with respect and treat them as I would like to be treated.
- I will not reply to any messages that are mean or in any way make me feel uncomfortable. It is not my fault if I get a message like that. If I do, I will tell my teacher right away.
