TUITION RATES¹ Payable monthly on a 10-month or 12-month plan. Payments due by the 20th of each month.

For families enrolling multiple children in the school:

2nd child – 10% discount

3rd child – 20% discount

4th child – 30% discount

5th child – 100% discount

Sample scenario:

A family enrolls 3 children (grades 8, 4, and K). Annual tuition would be \$5,010.00 for the 8th grade student, \$4,390.20 for the 4th grade student, and \$2,841.60 for the Kindergarten.

The oldest child is always considered the “first student.” Families with more than one student should list students in order of grade on the Student & Family Information Sheet.

CURRICULUM FEES

Curriculum costs will vary depending upon grade level and/or classes being taken. This cost will be determined after registration and divided into 10 monthly payments and billed the months of August through May. Early withdrawal from PCS prior to the end of the school year will require the payment of the balance of the curriculum costs in full. (Note: This fee works out to be approximately between \$20-\$40/month.)

ACTIVITY FEES *billed on the first statement of each school year*

Kindergarten \$45.00

Grades 1-12 \$80.00

Basketball/Volleyball/Soccer To be decided Billed the month following the start of the season.

Other activities are charged individually with prior notice being given.

Activity Fees help to cover the cost of various field trips throughout the year, elementary mother/daughter tea, elementary father/son mini golf, merit store, early Bible memory incentives, various classroom incentives, playground/gym equipment, and help offset the costs for events such as the High School Formal, Silverwood, etc.

TESTING FEES

Achievement Tests (grades 1-11) Approximately \$15-25 per student, billed the month following testing.

PSAT Tests Approximately \$20.00 billed the month following testing.

Placement Tests (New or current students) Billed at the time of testing. Fees vary depending on tests administered. Prices range from \$25-\$100.

OTHER EXPENSES

General school supplies and uniforms (including athletic wear) are additional expenses to those listed above. 7th-12th grade students must have a Chromebook purchased as a part of their school supplies. Also, there are some expenses not completely covered by Activity Fees such as occasional field trips, District Speech Meet participation, National Parks Trip, etc.

WITHDRAWAL FEE

Students withdrawn from the school after July 1st are subject to a withdrawal fee. The withdrawal fee, per child, is \$100.00 plus the remainder of the Curriculum Fees for the billing months left in the school year. This fee helps cover the expenses of records transfer, adjusting class rosters and curriculum which has already been purchased.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Pullman Christian School seeks to help families desiring to provide Christian schooling for their children but who may find it financially challenging to do so. Financial assistance is only applied toward tuition (excludes all other fees) and it is awarded based upon a family's ability to pay. We utilize an online application process, evaluated by an outside third party, and then the recommendation is brought to the Financial Aid Committee. There is a \$41.00 application fee that is due at the time of submitting the application online. Parents are notified of the amount of financial aid being awarded prior to the July 1st withdrawal deadline. This application must be completed by all continuing families desiring aid for the 2018-2019 school year, regardless of whether or not aid was received the prior year. POLICIES

Pullman Christian School depends on the tuition and fees of each student enrolling to meet its operation budget. It is expected that tuition payments be made promptly. All fees and tuition are non-refundable. Payments are due by the 20th of each month. Late fees will be assessed after that date. Failure to meet financial obligations could be grounds for student dismissal.
