_____ John 15:1	I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.
_____ John 15:2	Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit.
_____ John 15:3	You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.
_____ John 15:4	Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.
_____ John 15:5	I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.
_____ John 15:6	If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned.
_____ John 15:7	If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

Correct recitations of Bible Memory must adhere to the following guidelines:

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5. The student must say the section's scripture reference at the beginning of the section.

Bible Memory must be recited by the last day of the month.

The verification form is due to the student's Bible teacher no later than 3:00 p.m. on the 2nd school day of the following month.

_____ Heb. 12:2	Looking unto Jesus, the Author and Finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
_____ Heb. 12:5	And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to sons: "My son, do not despise the chastening of the Lord, nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him;
_____ Heb. 12:6	For whom the Lord loves He chastens, and scourges every son whom He receives."
_____ Heb. 12:7	If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten?
_____ Heb. 12:8	But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons.

_____ Heb. 12:10	For they indeed for a few days chastened us as seemed best to them, but He for our profit, that we may be partakers of His holiness.
_____ Heb. 12:11	Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.
_____ II Tim. 3:12	Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution.
