2. The adult may repeat anything that the student has already said correctly.
3. The adult may tell the student what verse the student is currently on.
4. The adult may tell the student if he or she said the verse correctly or incorrectly.
5. The student must say the section's scripture reference at the beginning of the section.

**Bible Memory must be recited by the last day of the month.**

**The verification form is due to the student's Bible teacher no later**

**than 3:00 p.m. on the 2<sup>nd</sup> school day of the following month.**
