

Cumulative Bible Memory Guidelines

The entire Cumulative Bible Memory selection and scripture references must be correctly recited to an adult in one sitting according to the following guidelines:

1. The student will be allowed *three* prompts (a word given that has not been previously said by the student).
2. The adult may repeat anything that the student has already said correctly.
3. The adult may tell the student what verse the student is currently on.
4. The adult may tell the student if he or she said the verse correctly or incorrectly.
5. The student must say the scripture reference at the beginning of each separate section if it is a consecutive group of scriptures or at the beginning of each scripture if they stand alone.

A student may receive the Cumulative Bible Memory Award if he or she has recited Cumulative and turned in this verification form to the school office by Friday, May 14, 2021, at 8:10 a.m.
