A student who wants to earn the Literature Award must follow these guidelines:

Grades K-4

- Student must read at least **20 books** between June 1st and the award's due date.
- Books should be at or above the student's reading level.
- Books required for classes may be included.
- Books must be read by the student, not be read to the student by an adult. Audio books may not be counted toward this award.
- PCS reserves the right to decline acceptance of any particular book (included in the 20 book count for the award) based upon content that is deemed to be contrary to the school's core values. For questions regarding what would or would not be accepted, please contact a teacher.
- The Literature Award documentation form must be completed and turned in by the deadline.

Grades 5-12

- Student must read a minimum of **4000 pages** between June 1st and the award's due date.
- Books should be at or above the student's reading level.
- Books must be read by the student, not be read to the student by an adult. Audio books may not be counted toward this award.
- Books required for classes may be included.
- PCS reserves the right to decline acceptance of any particular book (included in the 4000 page count for the award) based upon content that is deemed to be contrary to the school's core values. For questions regarding what would or would not be accepted, please contact a teacher.
